

Crimean military crisis escalates as all Ukrainian military assets have been seized by Russian forces

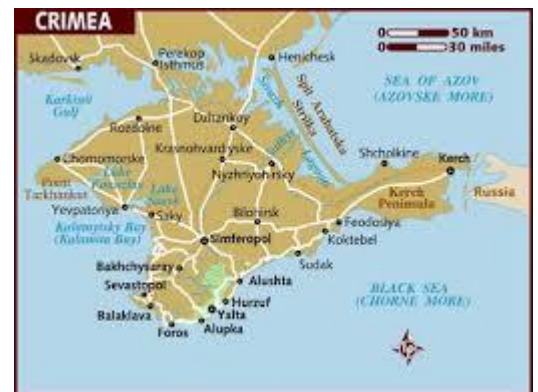
Russian troops have seized 3 Ukrainian military bases in the Crimea, killing two soldiers and causing one other minor injury.

Natalia Poklonskaya has defended Russia's military actions in the Crimea, saying that Russia should have full sovereignty over The Crimea, and that her movements were completely justified, and all that Russia wants to do is make peace and carry on regular routines in the Crimea, but these routines have been disrupted by the events in Kiev.

She has also stated that Russia's movements have not



breached any political or social laws, and are less chaotic than the events in Kiev, as it is more civil than the riots, as Crimea used to be Russian territory anyway, and that Russia only wants to protect the beliefs, laws and interests of the people of both Russia and the Crimea.



Russian forces have seized all of the military assets in the Crimea, including 2 Ukrainian warships and Ukraine's only submarine. Some Ukrainian sailors chose to stay on their vessels and serve with the Russian Military, whilst others packed up and left for bases within The Ukraine.

Since her statements and press conference, Natalia Poklonskaya has become wanted by the Ukrainian secret service for treason and betrayal of the country, as she is still a Ukrainian citizen, and was legal advisor to the Ukraine's head of state, but left to become Russian Chief Attorney of The Crimea, and Chief Prosecutor.

When her press conference video was released, it quickly went viral and amassed over 300,000 views in the first few hours, and now Japanese netizens have started drawing anime and manga fan-art of the prosecutor, some netizens have said things like "I want Natalia to grab me by the lapels, slap me twice and bury her foot more subtle things such as

in my gut." Whilst others said "Natalia puts the 'cute' in 'prosecute'."
